How to become a member of Manila FBC:

By receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord
 This means you wish to become a Christian and to commit your life to Jesus Christ.

By presenting yourself as a candidate for baptism - Baptism does not save us, but it is important. Always in the Bible, those who genuinely became Christians obediently followed Christ in Christian baptism.

By transferring your membership by letter If you are currently a member of another Baptist
church (having been saved and baptized previously),
you may transfer your membership to our church by
letter.

By statement of your Christian faith -

By restoration upon statement of prior conversion experience and baptism by immersion, when a letter is not available.

By baptism if from another Christian denomination - If you have received Christ in another denomination, you may come for baptism into our church (This does not judge as invalid your previous Christian commitment: rather, it is a positive indication of your commitment to become a part of our church.)

At the end of each worship service, an invitation is extended to those who wish to make public decisions for Christ and church membership. Simply speak with the pastor at the close of service if you have a decision you wish to make. If you have any questions or concerns, we encourage you to talk with the pastor ahead of time.





